Subject: Registering Your Teams For The 2011 Ohio State S.A.Y. Tournament

The 2011 Ohio State S.A.Y. Tournament (the OAST), sponsored by Little Miami SAY Soccer, will be held November 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> and November 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> at Little Miami High School in Morrow, Ohio.

**\*\*We are behind in getting this out to the areas and require a fairly quick turn around on this information. Please note the deadline for your entry request below.\*\***

Championship level teams from your Area are invited to participate. You are invited to send your Area champions. Your 2<sup>nd</sup> place team may also be sent to fill open slots if needed and will be placed by random draw.

If your Area sponsors more than one league in a division, it is your Area's responsibility to designate a single Area champion for each of the playing divisions; and you may determine who to send based upon whatever criterion is used within your Area to determine Area Champions and runners-up...

If your teams compete in a league with teams from other SAY Areas, only the winners of that league are eligible for Ohio Area State S.A.Y. Tournament play; and only they may determine who to send based upon whatever criterion is used within that League to determine Champions.

HOWEVER, you may apply to enter a team or teams directly if the League (or the hosting SAY Area) with which you interplay did NOT enter either First Place or runners-up Teams teams in that particular division with permission from your Area. Since other Interplaying teams may also apply, these slots are not guaranteed, and will be limited to selection by random draw.

You and your representatives are encouraged to attend this meeting as some decisions on procedures will be made by those attending.

You will be notified by e-mail after the bracketing draw as to the total number of First and Second Place (runner-up) teams accepted from your Area. Payment for those teams (\$100 per team) must be received by no later than 11:30 p.m., Friday, **October 28, 2011**.

It is planned that all relevant information will be posted on the tournament's Website ([www.ohiosay.org](http://www.ohiosay.org)) as it becomes available and that team packets will be emailed to your Area no later than **Monday, November 1, 2011**.

It will be your Area's responsibility to see that the proper teams receive them. Each packet will identify the playing division, the date, the time, and the field where each game is scheduled to be played and will contain other important information for you and your coaches. It is imperative that coaches bring that packet with them to their first game as it is the primary way the OAST can verify the identity of the team. Also remind coaches to bring 2 signed rosters to each game.
