The State Tournament is a one and out. Awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place will be given out.

Please make sure you read the OAST Tournament rules and follow them.

- Rules are on the website at www.ohiosay.org

Coaches MUST check in at the Trailer (TOAST Headquarters) before every game.

- See the map on the website
- Bring your signed roster that your Area turned in for you to check-in along with your concussion certificates for each coach/assistant before each game.
 - Bring notes/emails from any missing players that cannot play.
 - Must include phone numbers

All teams are required to have an adult (non-coach) keep track of time ... all players should be on the field – playing at least half of the game Guidelines can be found on the website. You will also receive a time sheet for each game.

- Time keepers **will need** a clipboard, stopwatch and pencils – each coach will need to supply these items.
- All time keepers will **track time for both teams** and confer with the other parent tracking time so that the times match.
- The timekeepers will sit on the team side at the half line – together. Players need to check-in and out with the time keepers.

The referees keep the official time on the field.

- It is their discretion to allow for additional time as a result unusual stoppage on the field

Coaches – need to be organized with subbing and take the subs to the half line and have those coming out come out at the half line

- If a player is hurt – communicate with the other coach and the referees and have the time keeper's document the injury

Winning coach returns both completed and signed timesheets (BOTH coach's MUST sign).

- This must be returned right after your game.

The team listed on the top of the bracket is the HOME team and responsible for game ball and color conflict – arrive prepared with air in a ball and scrimmage vests, as needed.
